Standing Rules and Committees

Standing Rules

1. Annual dues shall be \$20.00 from May 1 through April 30 of the following year, \$15.00 September 1 through April 30 of the following year, \$10.00 December 1 through April 30 of the following year \$5.00 March 1 through April 30. A \$2.00 Drop-in donation will be requested of non-member players per day.
2. Club hours will be Monday through Saturday from 9:00 am to noon, Sunday from noon to 3:00 pm – weather permitting.
3. During club hours, courts will be designated by skill level as:
 - a. One court lower/novice court – players stay until comfortable to play on the mixed/all level courts, rotating out for similar lower skilled players.
 - b. Up to two challenge courts – winning players stay with the same partner, up to three games. Losers leave. Players rotate through paddle queue on the right side of fence.
 - c. Up to five mixed/all level courts – first game on court, winning players stay. After that, all players play two games regardless of win or loss. Players can mix or stay with the same partner. Players rotate through paddle queue on the left side of fence.
4. The club mission statement is:
 - a. To grow the game of Pickleball for all ages, levels, and abilities by creating and cultivating an environment that promotes health, social interaction, good sportsmanship, and fun. We are a community-based club that provides continuing skill and mentoring programs to enhance organized recreational play.

Committees

Sanitation

Responsible for all contact with Port-a-Potty company and issues

Operations

Responsible for obtaining and training club volunteers to properly open/lockup club facility on organized playing days.

Tournament

Responsible for coordinating all aspects of an annual club tournament, including working with outside tournament organizations, and soliciting volunteers to handle tournament duties.

Court Maintenance

Responsible for ensuring maintenance of court surface, fencing and grounds are clean and free of harmful defects.

Equipment Maintenance

Responsible for ensuring that sufficient club nets, balls, storage units, and other equipment are available to facilitate play.

Events

Oversee club sponsored potlucks and other volunteer activities.

Training and Player Development

Responsible for designing and implementing in-house, skill-based training sessions, mentoring and coaching programs.

Advertising

Manages community outreach and media contacts, including maintaining GroupMe and Facebook pages.

City of Oregon City Liaison

Lead person to collaborate with the City of Oregon City to promote pickleball in the community.
